

# World Boerboel Auction – Information for bidders



The World Boerboel Auction to be held by the SA Boerboel Breeders Association (SABBA/SABT) on 25 October 2008 offers Boerboel breeders and enthusiasts globally the opportunity to own the best among the best of this sought-after South African dog breed.

Potential buyers, who cannot be present at the Auction in Parys in the Free State Province of South Africa, will be able to bid telephonically. Photos and registration certificates of the dogs and the contact details of the sellers will be available on the SABBA website: [www.sabt.co.za](http://www.sabt.co.za) from 25 September.

## Conditions for Auction sellers and their dogs

The dogs on offer – as well as semen of proven stud dogs – will be from:

1. Invited breeders/owners of SABBA registered dogs that participated in the 2007 National Show and regional shows.
2. Deserving applications by SABBA members with SABBA registered dogs that were not able to participate in the shows.
3. Sellers must comply with the following conditions:
  - 3.1. Puppies may not be younger than 6 weeks.
  - 3.2. All dogs offered for auction must have microchips.
  - 3.3. SABBA birth notifications must be submitted for puppies and registration (appraisal) certificates for adult dogs. These certificates include information such as the names and SABBA registration numbers of the dog, its parents' and lineage, and the seller's name and contact details.
  - 3.4. Certified copies must be submitted of veterinary health certificates relating to the dog's
    - hip and elbow dysplasia status (SABBA requirements – not less than 2:2 for both);
    - inoculations (puppies and adult dogs). The dates of the last vaccinations and deworming must be not more than 30 days and not less than 10 days prior to the Auction.
  - 3.5. Accept that SABBA officials will inspect the dogs on the day of the Auction for their suitability to be auctioned.
  - 3.6. The seller will be responsible for 10% commission on the bid price.

## Registration as Auction buyers

### Buyers attending the Auction

1. Buyers may register in person from 09:00 to 2 hours before the start of the proceedings, and will have the opportunity to inspect the dogs and consult with the sellers.
2. Buyers are responsible for payment of 14% Value Added Tax (VAT) on the bid price. SABBA will issue tax invoices to all buyers.
3. Payment is strictly cash or by bank guaranteed cheque, which must be made out to SABBA.
4. Buyers may take their dogs with them after the Auction, or use the services of the transport facilitator.

### Buyers bidding by phone

Serious bidders may register until Friday 17 October.

1. Telephone bidders must register in advance, and pay a refundable deposit of ZAR2000 into the Trust Account below. Please fax or e-mail proof of payment to Anemari Pretorius.
2. Telephone bidders will receive a confidential bid number, which SABBA will activate only after receiving proof of payment of the required deposit.
3. Buyers from abroad will be able to claim a refund on VAT when their dogs are exported.
4. Telephone bidders should preferably appoint their own representative to act on their behalf at the Auction (please confirm name and contact details). If this is not possible, SABBA will put you in contact with a volunteer representative.
5. SABBA strongly advises telephone bidders to consult with the sellers of dogs they are interested in for peace of mind about the qualities of those dogs and the normal guarantees. SABBA cannot accept responsibility for any latent defects, which may transpire later in a dog's life.
6. Buyers should also contact the transport/export facilitator in good time for a cost estimate of her services, which will include relevant official documentation, registration and health certificates, and transport and temporary accommodation arrangements.
